- Follow Up Action Items from Previous Meeting
  - New Board Members Needed
    - 2 parishioners from SSPP
    - Misty to send to Julie/Jane self-nomination form link and it will be sent out via FACTS to school families

- Principal Items
  - Staffing Update
    - Jessica Eschmann hired to help in the office and learn Julie and Jane's positions. Will need extra coverage as Julie will be out for medical leave intermittently.
    - Pat Row is also on call to help when additional admin help is needed
    - Lori Matzenbacher will be out starting Wed, Sept 14<sup>th</sup> for 4-8 weeks on medical leave.
    - All other positions filled except Latchkey help. Still need adult help in Latchkey.
  - New Assessment Tool
    - Transitioning from STAR testing to i-Ready: Provides more information about students' abilities in reading and math. Will help teachers offer more differentiated instruction. Piloting program in 1<sup>st</sup> grade this year.
    - No investment required for piloting program this year. If we switch from STAR, i-Ready will be more expensive (+\$4000) than STAR program (currently paying about \$5000). This increase would need to be allocated in the next school year budget or possibly included in EdFirst campaign.
  - Miscellaneous Active Shooter Training
    - Held first intruder drill with students
    - Need a meeting place for students in the event of an active shooter must be off-campus, but nearby. Location/business has been contacted but we are waiting on their board approval.
    - Communication will be sent to all families identifying a "parent reunification point" outside so parents can find their children if the school would need quick evacuation
    - Classroom doors will be fit with wood barrier "locks" provided by Liz and Jared Schaltenbrand
    - All classroom doors now have push button locks on the inside doorknobs/handles
    - Will be hosting another session with police dept since some staff could not attend the first training session
    - Board recommended a note be sent to parents to inform them that we have new office staff and be patient as we screen for security
    - Additional board discussion was had
- New Business
  - Gibault use of school bus
    - Gibault is requesting to house our bus on their property and increase use of our bus
    - Board consensus is the bus should remain on SPPCS property and keep arrangement in the status quo as we are currently not charging Gibault for use as-needed, but final decision lies with the parish/school administration
  - Ideas for Ed First
    - Religion curriculum (waiting on Bishop approval so were unable to purchase this year)
    - Chromebooks and iPads were ALL updated this year
    - Alison suggested Microsoft Office Products
    - i-Ready testing (to replace STAR testing)
    - Junior high requests tables/desks and chairs
    - Covered awning for front door of school
    - New cafeteria tables
  - SPPCS Family Survey Board to review family survey draft and finalize in Oct meeting
