 - Discussion was had around uniform colors and options for next year. Changes were tabled for next year. May revisit next year before Open House and suggestion to include it on the survey for the fall to get parent's opinions.

Principal Items

- o Gala Update
 - Need 368 more raffle tickets sold to get gator
 - Dinner tickets at 260, last year 312 sold
 - Live will be about 50 items
 - Still receiving silent auction items
- o Enrollment/Staffing
 - Enrollment: 204 K-8 and 53 Pre-K potentially for next year
 - 17 potential new students for K-8
 - Looking at adding another 3rd grade teacher as that class may grow to 27 students
 - Close to hiring a Summer Splash Director
 - Darlene Niebreugge leaving, Joyce Everson leaving, Stephanie Biffar moving to Cafeteria Director position and will need replacement for her.
 - Jane Briesacher will retire and Jess Eschmann will take her place. Will need to hire replacement Admin Assistant.
- Preschool Start Time
 - Pre-K teachers are resisting to start earlier because they like that morning period as prep time
 - Lori Matzenbacher suggests if you have an older sibling you could drop all off at 7:15 you could drop all kids to sit in the cafeteria without paying latchkey.
 - Discussion was had and general consensus was this may be a solution to appease both parties (at least in the short term)
- o Curriculum Update
 - New Religion Curriculum coming from Bishop this spring
 - Also reviewing lower elementary science curriculum
- Queen of Hearts Projects

- Lori Matzenbacher and Scott (maintenance director) meeting with Steve Goessling (parish) on Wednesday morning to discuss projects and status
- Inside of front doors of school now have safety and security film installed outside will be done when the weather is warmer
- o Ed First Project Update
 - No plans draw up on pavilion for playground but will work with parish council on options for moving forward. There are concerns about blocking gate and needing to find best placement.
- o Budget item discussion
 - Emily Kimutis has sent a budget wrap up message to Lori Matzenbacher and Misty Yanko but they have not reviewed it yet to share with the board
 - Diocese will still be able to tax us ~11% even if we move Queen of Hearts money to Money Market Account
