RELIGION



Our Catholic faith is practiced and present each day.

READING

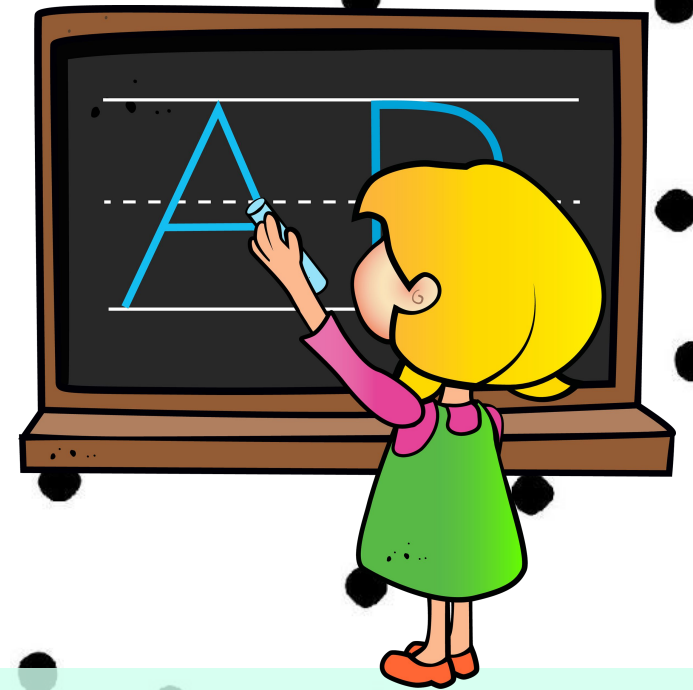


We will have a weekly themed story which will help focus on grammar, phonics, and language.

WRITING



We start the year with guiding writing graphic organizers.

Students will progress to and learn how to write a paragraph of their own with a given topic.

Cursive is taught after Christmas.

MATH

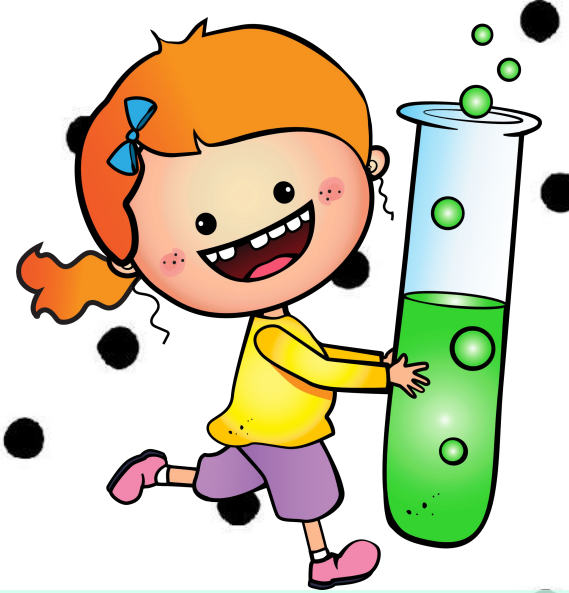


The core of second grade math is learning how to add and subtract with regrouping.

Students will learn how to tell time to the nearest 5 minutes.

Other concepts are money, measurement, arrays, and geometric shapes.

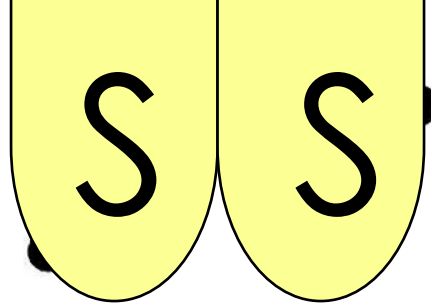
SCIENCE
